## **NOTICE**

Attention of all the practicing advocates enrolled with Bar Council of Delhi and who are also an elector of Delhi is hereby invited that the last date for registration under the Chief Minister Advocates' Welfare Scheme for availing benefits of Group (Term) insurance providing life cover of Rs. 10,00,000/-(Rupees Ten Lakhs) and Group Medi-claim coverage for advocates, their spouse and two dependent children up to the age of 25 years, for a family floater sum insured of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs) has been extended up to 11:59 PM of 10/04/2023.

All interested and eligible advocates may get themselves registered and thereafter, apply for the year 2023-24 under this scheme at <a href="https://www.cmaws.delhi.gov.in">www.cmaws.delhi.gov.in</a> on/before the aforesaid schedule.

Further, it has also been noticed by this department that a large number of such advocates, who had applied under this scheme, on previous occasions (i.e. in Year 2020 & 2022) and who are already a beneficiary under the said scheme, which is valid till 15.05.2023, have not again applied through the above said portal. In this regard, it is again clarified that it is mandatory for all such advocates also, who intend to continue to avail benefits under the scheme, beyond 15.05.2023. It is reiterated that the benefits under the Chief Minister Advocate Welfare Scheme would only be extended to the advocates, who apply for the scheme afresh for the year 2023-24 and are found eligible in terms of Cabinet Decision No. 2794 dated 18/12/2019. In case any such advocate, fails to apply for the year 2023-24, the benefits under the Group Term Insurance & Group Medi-claim Insurance under Chief Minister Advocate Welfare Scheme, shall not be extended to such advocates.
